Our barn is completely handicapped-accessible.


We have a one-to-one counselor to child ratio for all our campers. Our staff is trained to work with children of all abilities.

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Our camp is on a beautiful 17 acre farm in West Chester, PA near Unionville. Your child will start the day by being transported on a very special hayride from the end of our scenic country lane to The Barn. Since the wagon is handicapped-accessible, all children are able to participate. The rest of the morning will be filled with physical activities and games. Whether your child is kicking around an enormous soccer ball or body bowling in the barn's loft... they will be having fun! A short snack period

is followed with physical and gross motor activities and interaction with The Barn's animals— miniature horses, goats, bunnies, a pot-bellied pig and more. After lunch there is an opportunity for quieter play time in our handicapped-accessible tree house equipped with sensory stimulating challenges. Later in the afternoon, your child might play with a large, colorful parachute, run through sprinklers to cool off, tend to our raised vegetable and flower beds or engage in a variety of arts and



crafts activities as the day winds down.
