Programs: \$250,139.48 (84%)

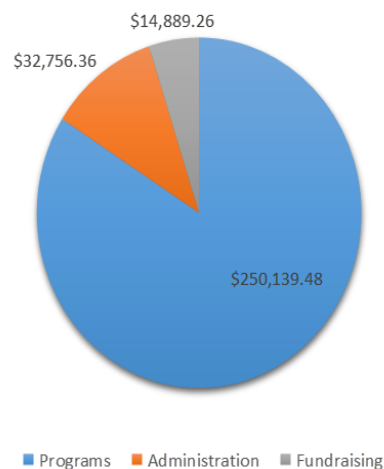
